Recipe Corner

Pumpkin Five-Spice Butter

1 cup (2 sticks) unsalted butter, room temperature
1/3 cup canned or fresh pumpkin puree, strained
1 tablespoon orange or lemon zest, finely grated
1 1/2 to 2 tablespoons Chinese five-spice powder (Bottled five-spice powder can often be found in supermarkets, specialty food stores or in Asian markets.)
Salt to taste

Optional: confectioners' sugar or honey powder for sweeter applications; 1/4 cup chopped walnuts or pecans

Place the butter in a medium mixing bowl and with an electric mixer or wooden spoon, beat until light and fluffy. Scrape down the sides.

Add pumpkin puree, zest and five-spice powder, scrapping down the sides of the bowl, and beat to incorporate all ingredients. Taste for five-spice powder and salt.

Add confectioners' sugar if desired. Stir in nuts if desired, and taste again for salt.

Scrape into a small bowl, serving crock or butter molds and cover tightly; or shape into a long roll in grease-proof paper (plastic, wax or parchment) for storing and slicing as needed.

Recipe Corner

Brainy Burrito

2 eggs
1 whole wheat tortilla
1 tablespoon refried beans
1/4 cup low-fat cheese
2 tablespoons salsa
1/2 avocado, sliced
Nonstick spray
Spray nonstick skillet with cooking spray.

Beat eggs; pour into skillet and cook, stirring continually, until slightly set, about 2 minutes. Add cheese.

Spread refried beans on tortilla. Cover with a damp paper towel and microwave for 30 seconds.

Spread egg and cheese filling down the center of the tortilla. Add salsa and sliced avocado.

Fold one side of the tortilla over filling. Fold up bottom. Roll securely.
